To authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the year ending on thirty first day of March, 2021 -

Be it enacted by the Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly in the Seventy First year of the Republic of India as follows:-

short title

 This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation Act. 2020.

Issue of Rs.535269737000 out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand for the year 2020-21 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column-3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs 535269737000 (Rs.Fifty three thousand five hundred twenty six Crore Ninety Seven Lakh Thirty Seven Thousand only) towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2021 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
