(Act No. 07 of 2014)

To authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the year ending on thirty first day of March, 2015 -

> An Act

Be it enacted by the State Assembly in the Sixty Fifth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1- This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation Act, 2014.

2- From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column-3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs.303537786000 (Thirty Thousand Three hundred fifty three Crore Seventy Seven Lakhs Eighty Six Thousands only) towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2015 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
